U.S. ARMY EDUCATION BENEFITS

If you want to go to college and you're currently in high school, the U.S. Army can help pay for your education. Listed below are a few benefits available to Soldiers in the Army:

4-YEAR MINUTEMAN SCHOLARSHIPS

The Minuteman Scholarship covers full tuition and fees (uncapped) or \$10,000 per year toward room and board at any college or university served by an Army Reserve Officer's Training Corps (ROTC) program.

CONCURRENT ADMISSIONS PROGRAM (CONAP)

Enlist in the Army or Army Reserve and attend college at the same time.

ENLISTMENT BONUS

As a qualified active duty recruit, you may earn an enlistment bonus of up to \$40,000 for select jobs.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Qualified Soldiers receive up to \$4,000 annually and other educational assistance is available through the Montgomery G.I. Bill (MGIB) and the Post 9/11 Educational Assistance Act.

PARTNERSHIP FOR YOUTH SUCCESS (PaYS)

The Army partners with companies, corporations and public sector agencies to provide job interviews and potential employment to Army Soldiers.
